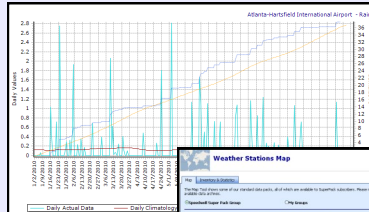

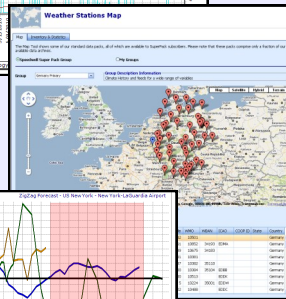

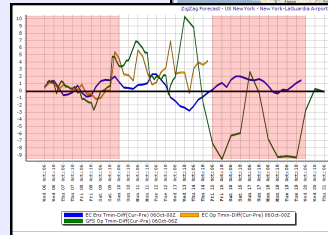
Actuals Vs Climatology

A quick guide of the day to day change in modeled CME futures prices as a result of change in the forecast and the impact of daily accrual

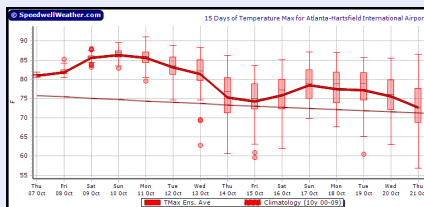

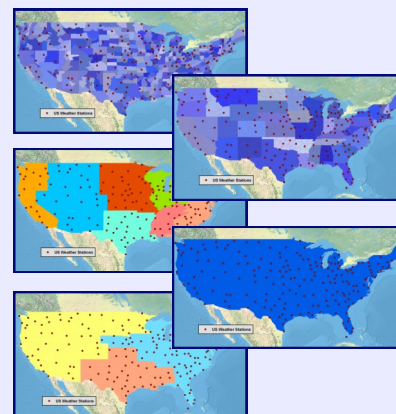

Weighted Degree Days
